PRIVACY POLICY

With this privacy policy we inform you about whether and how, to what extent, for what purpose and on what legal basis personal data (e.g. your IP address or email address) is processed when you visit and use our website at www.buergerstiftung-heppenheim.de (hereinafter referred to as: Internet page or website), the duration of the data processing and your rights, in particular the right to information and your right to object to the processing of your personal data and/or to revoke your consent.

The processing of personal data, in particular the collection, recording, organization and storage of such data, is carried out in accordance with the applicable data protection regulations, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

I. NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE RESPONSIBLE PERSON

II. GENERAL

The term "personal data" includes all information that can be assigned to an identified or identifiable person (for example name, e-mail address, but also IP address). "_processing_" means any process in connection with personal data, such as collecting, recording, organizing, arranging, storing, adapting or changing, reading, querying, using, disclosing by transmission, disseminating or otherwise making available, comparing or linking, restricting, deleting or destroying. Other terms such as "person responsible" and "consent" are defined in the GDPR (Art. 4 GDPR). Reference is made to the legal definitions.

Our website provides information about the activities of the community foundation, past and current projects, and information about the foundation's supporters. You can use our website purely for information purposes, without providing any personal information. If you contact us, e.g. by email, personal data will be processed, in particular collected, recorded and stored.

Personal data will only be processed if processing is permitted by law or if you have given us your consent. Personal data may be necessary to provide a functional website.

There are always security gaps when data is transmitted over the Internet. Therefore, absolute protection of personal data from access by third parties is never possible.

III. DATA PROCESSING

You can visit our website without having to provide any personal information (informational use).

1. DATA PROCESSING BY EMAIL

The website does not offer an integrated option for contacting us using a contact form. You can contact us using the email address provided. If you contact us in this way, your personal data transmitted with the email, the email address, name, IP address, date and time of sending,

subject of the email and other contact details will be saved. The data will not be passed on to third parties. The data will only be used to answer your inquiry and for correspondence with you.

The legal basis for processing the data transmitted when sending an email is Art. 6 Para. 1 f) GDPR. If the email contact is aimed at concluding a contract, the additional legal basis for processing is Art. 6 Para. 1 b) GDPR.

The data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required to achieve the purpose for which it was collected. The personal data that you sent by email will be saved on our server. If the user contacts us by email, he can object to the storage of his personal data at any time.

In such a case, the conversation cannot be continued.

If you wish to object to the processing of your personal data, simply send an email to: mt (at) tieconsult.de. Your personal data that was saved when you contacted us will then be deleted by us immediately.

2. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

You have extensive rights when processing your personal data.

You have a right to information free of charge (Art. 15 GDPR) and can, if necessary, request the correction (Art. 16 GDPR) and/or deletion (Art. 17 GDPR) and/or blocking of your personal data. You can also request a restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR). You have a right of objection (Art. 21 GDPR) and a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR). If you have given your consent, you have the right to revoke it (Art. 7 Para. 3 GDPR).

In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR) if you believe that the processing of your personal data has not been carried out lawfully.
